Proper way to do citations

Journal article: names of authors, name of journal, year, volume, page numbers

Example: Orna, M. V.; Mathews, T. F. ; *Studies in Conservation*, **1981**, 26, 57-72.

Book: Names of authors, name of text, publisher, place published, year

Example: Falk, D. S.; Brill, D. R.; Stork, D. G.; *Seeing the Light: Optics in Nature, Photography, Color, vision, and Holography*, John Wiley & Sons: New York, 1986.

Web site: URL (date of access, Month and Year are sufficient)
