**Guidelines for Receiving 2 Upper Division Credits
In Botanical Studies (including Botanical Medicine)**

In response to several requests from students for receiving Upper Division Natural Science credits, Marja has prepared these general guidelines. This option is ONLY available for continuing students.

1. Indicate the number of credits you currently have and your year in school. You must be either a Junior or Senior.
2. Write a brief description of the background upon which you will be building in the work you will do for these credits. (Look in the calendar at the topics to be covered that are related to botany and botanical medicine before doing this.)
3. Indicate your agreement to prepare a very high quality, extensive and thorough plant monograph that draws upon 8-10 sources.
4. Also indicate your agreement follow up the botany activities and readings with specific assignments and demonstration of knowledge gained as well as to assist with the botany activities.

Your request for consideration should include each of the above points and must be received by Marja no later than Wednesday, 18 January (Week 2). It may be submitted in hard copy during class or e-mailed to eloheimo@evergreen.edu.
